AY2024 Process for Nominating Faculty for Committee Service

Every fall, faculty receive a survey where they can put their names forward to volunteer for service on a number of standing/special Faculty and standing Institute committees. *This process overview pertains only to the Standing Faculty committees and Faculty Award committees.*

This year there were 19 spots open on the Standing Faculty committees, eight spots open on the two Faculty Award committees, and two spots open on the Committee on Nominations. Terms on all of these begin July 1, 2024. Here is the breakdown of total openings by School at the start of AY2024;¹ a list of committee acronyms is below:

- SA+P: 7 (CAP, CoC, CGP, CLS, CUP, Edgerton, CoN)
- Engineering: 5 (CCP, CGP, Edgerton, Killian, CoN)
- SHASS: 6 (CCP, CoC, CSL, CUP, Edgerton, Killian)
- Science: 3 (CUAFA, Edgerton, Killian)
- Sloan: 2 (CSL, Killian)
- Any School: 6 (2 COD, 3 2 FPC, CGP, CUAFA)

Three of the SA+P openings were not able to be filled from that School. In consultation with the respective committees, these were filled by SHASS (CAP), Engineering (CUP), and Engineering/College (CoC).

The Any School openings were filled by: SA+P (FPC, CUAFA), Science (COD, CGP), Sloan (COD, FPC).

Of the 29 faculty who agreed to be nominated to serve on standing/special Faculty committees, 11 have not previously served on any of the standing/special Faculty committees or the standing Institute committees, and an additional five have served on standing Institute committees but not standing/special Faculty committees.

CoN members also approached 21 faculty who declined to be nominated, primarily due to being overcommitted, though there were a few instances of teaching conflicts as well.

At the conclusion of the recruitment process, the committees slate enclosed with the Faculty Meeting agenda can be broken down as follows, including the Any School openings and CoN:

- SA+P: 6
- Engineering and Engineering/College: 7

¹ As more faculty become affiliated with the Schwarzman College of Computing, CoN is seeking to fill open slots with faculty in this category as well as considering School affiliation.

² "Any School" openings happen when committee members continuing the next academic year on a particular committee represent each of the five Schools, so nominees can be from any School.

³ The COD is the one exception to five School representation: because of the nature of the committee's work, empathy and ability to work with students in difficult situations are more important than School.
