It serves as a liaison between the Libraries and their users. The committee also monitors and upholds the MIT Faculty Open-Access Policy, which details the process for disseminating scholarly research.

The Committee on the Library System consists of six elected Faculty members, two graduate student members, two undergraduates, two postdocs, and the following *ex officio* members: the Provost (or representative), the Head of Information Services and Technology (or representative), and the Director of Libraries and two members of the Library Staff designated by the Director.
